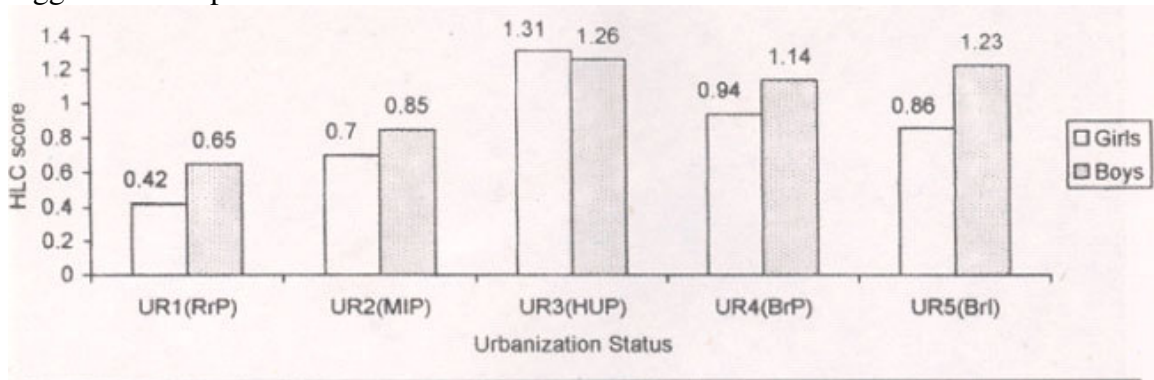


Figure 2. Health locus of control (HLC) score of children according to urbanisation rank and sex.
